Miles Nadal has had a long history with Mount Sinai Hospital and has always inspired and motivated others to give. More than two decades ago, he established Leadership Sinai, a young professionals group that raises money for Sinai Health. He also founded Sinai Health Foundation's longest running event the Mount Sinai Golf Classic now in its 24^{th} year. Combined, these initiatives have raised over \$20 million.
